- **Save Nature**—Contribute to save our precious environment . Minimize the wastage of resources like water, fuel and electricity.



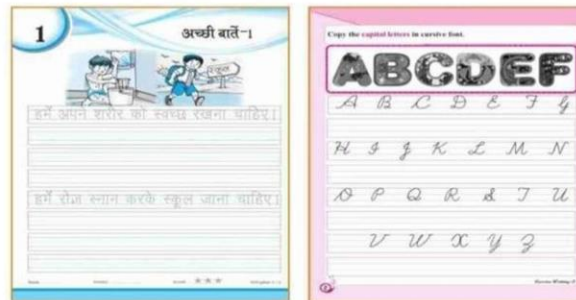
- **Read Hindi and English story books and children's Science Magazine** so that each child can contribute to the school Magazine like Champak, Nandan in some way or the other.
